

The Canadian Gift Association supports an Exhibitor Code of Ethics, adopted by the Canadian Gift Association Board of Directors.

As a Canadian Gift Association member exhibitor, or a non-member exhibitor, you are pledged to observe high standards of honesty, integrity, and responsibility in the conduct of business at the Canadian Gift Association Markets by:

- Respecting the rights and privileges of other Canadian Gift Association members, and non-members exhibiting at the Canadian Gift Association Markets.
- Adhering to the show's Rules and Regulations as outlined in the Exhibitor Manual.
- Maintaining and monitoring effective show security and safety procedures.
- Not entering into another exhibitor's booth, nor handling any product without expressed permission from the exhibitor.
- Being considerate of neighboring exhibitors and ensuring that your exhibit does not unduly interfere with their ability to conduct business.

No cameras or picture taking is allowed at anytime during the show without expressed permission from the exhibitor.

All dealings with Canadian Gift Association staff, show contractors, members and non-members will be conducted at all times in a professional, respectful and courteous manner.

In the event that a member exhibitor or non-member exhibitor is responsible for activities which do not follow the Canadian Gift Association Market Rules and Regulations or Code of Ethics, Canadian Gift Association members may lose their status as a 'member in good standing' resulting in the loss of membership privileges—which may also include the loss of booth space at the Canadian Gift Association Market for both members and non-members.
